School Re-entry Plan

Phase 1

Areas addressed based on RIDE Guidance

- Arrival and Dismissal procedures
- Stable Pods of no more than 30 - proposed schedule
- Social Distancing - rituals and routines of the building
- Masks to be worn by staff and students
- Breakfast and Lunch considerations

Arrival/Dismissal

- Arrival and Dismissal will look different than in the past
- The gym and the cafe will not be used for large group gatherings as students arrive or are dismissed
- Students may be assigned a door for arrival and dismissal based on how they are transported to school (bus, walker, parent drop off)
- Student lockers will not be used. All belongings will be kept in the classroom.

Instruction using stable pods

- Teachers and students will remain in a stable pod through Phase One remaining in one room with the same teacher.
- September will be focused on building rituals and routines, remediation for skills and standards missed in the previous year as well as building strong relationships with students.
- All Instruction will need to have “virtual” components and be flexible for multiple learning environments.
- Teachers will continue to use Google Classroom to post lesson resources.

Ritual and Routines Following Social —Distancing Guidelines/Recommendations

- Rituals and routines of the classroom and building
 - Electronic hall pass system must be used by all
 - Bathrooms - assigned by pods and disinfected in between each pod using that bathroom
 - Hallways - one way with identified 6 ft spacing
 - Classrooms - students will be as far apart as possible: 3 - 6 ft apart when possible

Breakfast and Lunch Considerations

- Breakfast

- will be served in the cafeteria for all students as a grab and go

- Lunch

- Grab N Go style
- We will move to 5 lunches to meet spacing requirements
- Multiple locations will be used for lunch. The number of students in the cafeteria for each scheduled lunch is based on RIDE guidance stating stable Pods must be separated by 14 feet
- Outside spaces will be open as well for as long as possible.
- Additional custodial support to allow for cleaning/disinfecting before the next Pod enters

11:00-11:30 - 2nd Lunch

11:30-12:00 - 3rd Lunch

12:00-12:30 - 4th Lunch
