Schedule Considerations

To mitigate movement and increase the occurrence of stable groups using consistent space, we would utilize a schedule where:

Quarter 1 - Periods 1, 2, 3, and 4 are scheduled

Quarter 2 - Periods 5, 6, 7, and 8 are scheduled

If we are able to safely utilize all 8 periods across Quarters 3 and 4, then we will use our Blue Day and White Day Schedule ([link](#)); if we are not able to safely utilize all 8 periods at that time then Periods 1, 2, 3, and 4 will be scheduled during Quarter 3; Periods 5, 6, 7, and 8 will be scheduled during Quarter 4



Proposed Rotation Schedule

Quarter 1 - Day A: Periods 1 and 2; Day B: Periods 3 and 4

Quarter 2 - Day C: Periods 5 and 6; Day D: Periods 7 and 8

Daily Schedule:

7:25 am - Teacher Report to Classrooms

7:25 am to 7:40 am - Staggered Student Arrival to Classrooms

7:40 am to 10:25 am - First Period

10:25 am to 10:35 am - Passing Time

10:35 am to 1:50 pm - Second Period (30 minutes per lunch for four lunches)

1:50 pm to 2:05 pm - Staggered Dismissal from Classrooms (for student drivers, walkers, parent pick up, and bussed students)



Breakfast and Lunch Considerations

Breakfast - will be served in the cafeteria for all students as a grab and go

Lunch - will be served in the cafeteria during the second period of each day. The number of students in the cafeteria for each scheduled lunch is based on the allowable statewide gathering size. Students will also have an outdoor tent to eat lunch under to better space students. Students who are taking PE will eat in the small gymnasium. A tentative schedule for lunches is as follows:

1st Lunch - 10:50 am to 11:20 am

2nd Lunch - 11:30 am to 12:00 pm

3rd Lunch - 12:10 pm to 12:40 pm

4th Lunch - 12:50 pm to 1:20 pm



Limited, Partial, and Virtual Considerations

Limited- (25%) and Partial- (50%) in-Person - last name alphabetic order will be used to determine on any given day which students are in-person on our campus and which students are off campus participating virtually. State guidance will dictate what percentage of students is allowed to be on campus on any given day. We will use the Daily Schedule described above for Quarters 1 and 2. Decisions for Semester 2 will be based on whether we are running four or eight periods at the time of the move to Limited- or Partial-In-Person. Consideration will be also be given to additional cleaning that may be necessary as part of Limited- or Partial-In-Person and how that might necessitate more asynchronous teaching and learning.

Virtual - all students attend school off-campus and virtually. In that scenario we will follow our distance learning schedule ([link](#)) with Blue Day in Quarter 1 and White Day in Quarter 2. Determination about whether we utilize Blue and/or White Day in Semester 2 will be based on whether students are participating in four or eight periods at the time we move to full Virtual.

Athletics/Clubs/Activities/After School Academic Support - will follow RIIL guidelines. Access to late busses will be predicated on the existence of after school activities.
