## An Important Message for Our South Kingstown Learning Community (update #8)

We will NOT HAVE SCHOOL IN the school buildings of SOUTH KINGSTOWN for the remainder of March and April. We will continue with our virtual learning until May 1. The Governor, RIDE, and RIDOH said that they will review this at the end of April but they have shared that it is likely that we may be out longer. Our virtual learning days are school days and they will count as school days.

Also, the Governor, RIDE, and RIDOH have shared that we will have professional development days (students do not have school) on April 3 and April 17. We will also have school vacation days on April 9 and 10. (SKSD already had a vacation day on April 10.)

Since mid-March, members of the South Kingstown Learning Community have been implementing a virtual learning plan that is grounded in the best interest of our children.
